



The Cape South Easter International Historic Race Day BULLETIN # 2

Clarification and General Information

1. LOTUS CHALLENGE CLASSES

To clarify the classes for the Lotus Challenge Race:

Class A: engines up to 2litre, full slicks allowed, full racing class (no windscreen, lights etc needed)

Class B: only for Toyota 4AGE 20 valve engine, semi slicks only, full racing class (no windscreen, lights etc needed)

Class C: road going class (must have windscreen, lights etc) engines up to 2litre, semi slicks or road tyres

Class X: open invitation class, meant for cars that do not comply to above classes.

If the car complies with classes A, B or C they can enter in those but can also elect to race in X if they choose to. Cars that do not comply with the 3 classes will default into class X.

This is not a championship race.

2. FINE CARS

To run under WPMC rules. In brief:

Cars up to Dec 1989 could/will enter.

Tyres, could be road or Semi's, but NO Slicks.

All cars entered for the weekend, will have to Qualify on Saturday.

Qualify times on Saturday, will be the Grid for Heat 1. (If not on grid, will start at back of grid.)

All races will be Standing Start.

Heat 2 will be the results of Heat 1 (if a DNF, back of grid)

All results will be "Index-system".

3. G T Cars

All cars that have been built prior to 01 January 1984 must enter in one of the Historic Classes– All cars built after 01 January 1984 must enter the G T Challenge Class.

4. Payment of Entry Fees
